## DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO WILMINGTON

*NOTE: US 68 will be closed north of Wilmington between Gurneyville and Hoskins Roads.*

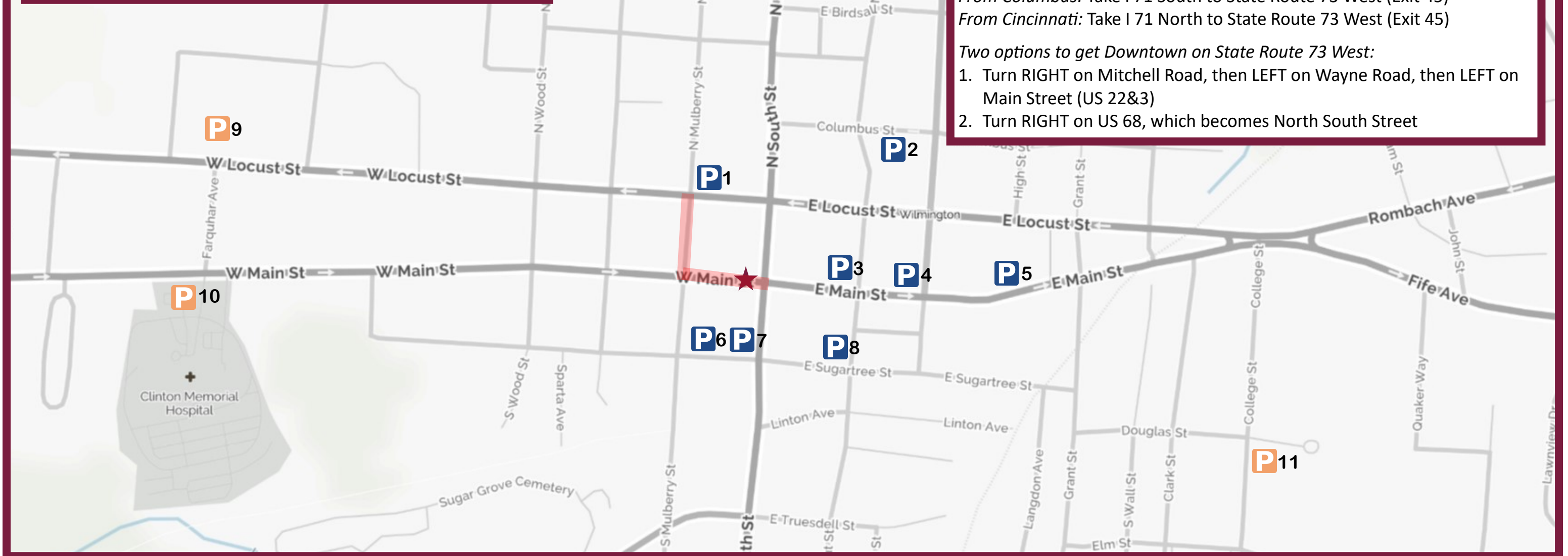
*From Dayton:* Take State Route 73 West

*From Columbus:* Take I 71 South to State Route 73 West (Exit 45)

*From Cincinnati:* Take I 71 North to State Route 73 West (Exit 45)

*Two options to get Downtown on State Route 73 West:*

1. Turn RIGHT on Mitchell Road, then LEFT on Wayne Road, then LEFT on Main Street (US 22&3)
2. Turn RIGHT on US 68, which becomes North South Street



**Downtown Parking**—On-street parking is available throughout the Downtown area, as well as in designated lots:

1. Fiesta Veracruz/City of Wilmington—West Locust and North Mulberry Streets
2. First Christian Church—120 Columbus Street
3. Mediterranean Restaurant/Wilmington United Methodist Church—East Main and North Walnut Streets
4. People’s Bank/Kentucky Friend Chicken—East Main and Lincoln Streets
5. Get Fit—283 East Main Street
6. Quali-Tee Design Sportswear—59 West Sugartree Street
7. For the Love of Ink/City of Wilmington—South South and West Sugartree Streets
8. Clinton County Courthouse—East Sugartree and South Walnut Streets

9. Wilmington High School—300 Richardson Place (0.7 miles)
10. Clinton Memorial Hospital Professional Building—610 West Main Street (0.5 miles)
11. Wilmington College Boyd Cultural Arts Center—College and Douglas Streets (0.7 miles)

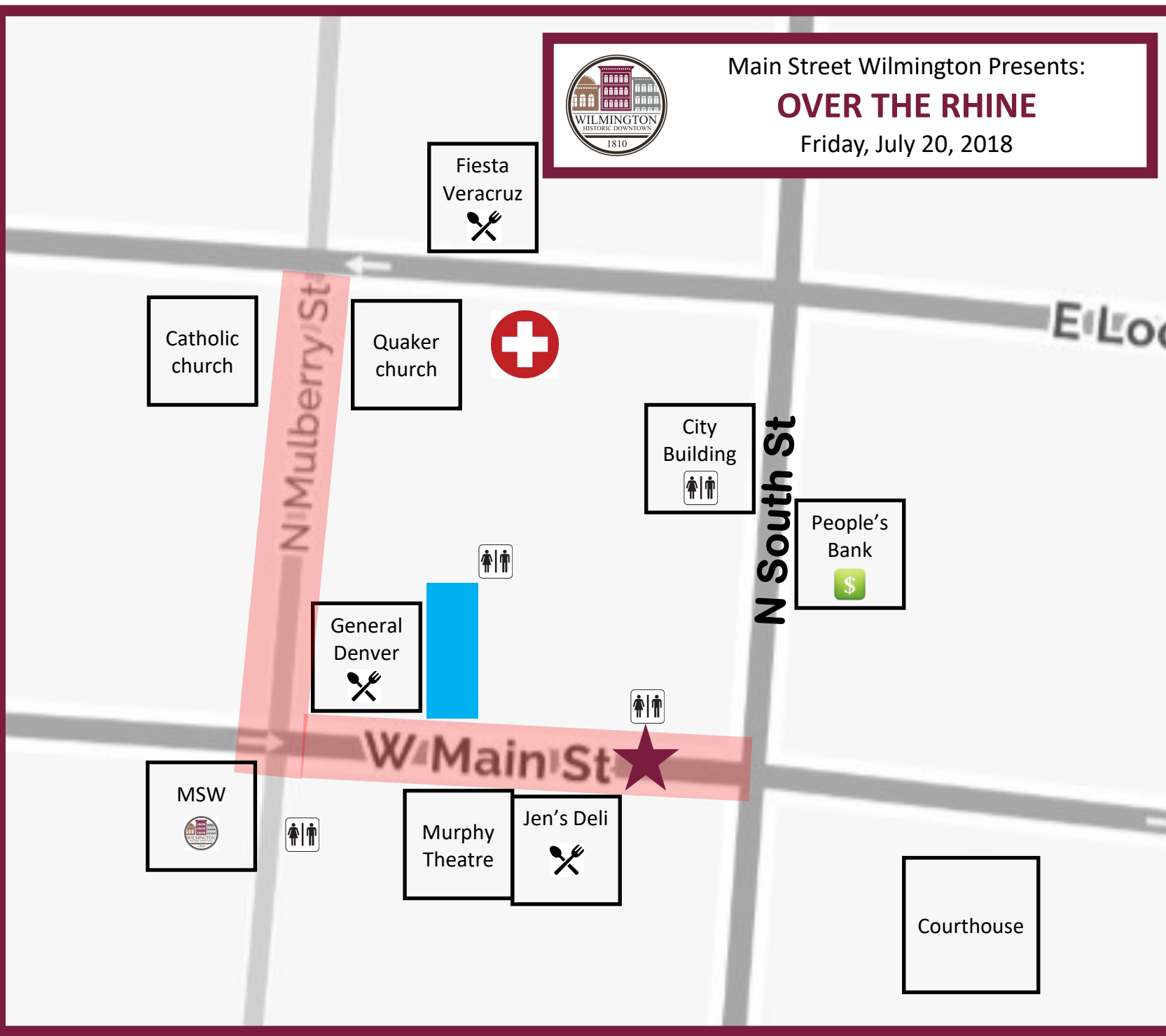


**Street Closed/Pedestrian Traffic Only:**

**Stage**

- Over The Rhine takes the stage at 7 p.m. There is no opening act.
- Festival-style seating opens at 4:30 p.m.
  - ⇒ Lawn chairs and blankets are permitted on Main Street.
  - ⇒ Sidewalks on Main Street must remain clear—no chairs, blankets, or loitering.



**Food/Water/Soda**

- Food trucks will be ready to serve at 5 p.m.—North Mulberry Street
  - Beaugard’s BBQ
  - Donatos
  - Food Fellas
  - Fruitful
  - Kona Ice
  - Pup Pies
  - Steak & Gravy
  - Walker’s Farm to Fork
- General Denver Hotel—eat in and take out—corner of Main and Mulberry Streets
- Jen’s Deli—eat in and take out—Main Street by the stage
- Fiesta Veracruz—eat in—Locust Street across from the City Building parking lot



**Restrooms**—Look for the GREEN directional signs

- City Building (inside, first floor, men’s and women’s—diaper changing table in women’s)
- Alley behind Mural Parking Lot (3 Porta Johns)
- South Mulberry Street off the Samuel Walker Building parking lot (2 Porta Johns)
- Alley between Athena’s and the CVB on Main Street (2 Porta Johns)



**ATM**

- People’s Bank (48 North South Street, across from City Building)
- Wilmington Savings Bank (184 North South Street, not shown on map)



**Street Closed/Pedestrian Traffic Only**

- West Main Street—Mulberry to South Street
- North Mulberry Street—East Locust to West Main Street



**Mural Parking Lot**

- Over The Rhine merchandise table
- Table seating
- Beer, beer tickets, pop, and water sales
- ID check



**First Aid**

- An ambulance will be stationed in the City Building parking lot.

**Beer**

- Beer sales start at 4:30 p.m. and go until 10 p.m.
  - Beer is \$4 each, or 5 for \$19.
  - You must have your ID checked and receive a wristband at one of the white Main Street Wilmington tents (in the Mural Parking Lot and on the corner of Main and Mulberry Streets) BEFORE purchasing beer or beer tickets.
  - Beer tickets can be purchased at the white Main Street Wilmington tents (in the Mural Parking Lot and on the corner of Main and Mulberry Streets) for cash or credit, or at the beer carts (credit only).
  - Beer can be purchased directly (no tickets needed) at the beer carts (credit only)—wrist bands REQUIRED.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted beyond the closed streets and the Mural Parking Lot.
- No outside alcoholic beverages permitted.

**Water bottles** can be refilled at the water fountain in the City Building.
